



SK: Anticipated rules and conditions of tenders for the new procedures of the electricity of the alternative source of energy

On 6 November 2019 the Ministry of Economy of the Slovak Republic (the "ME SR") announced on the informative meeting the new tender rules and conditions for the producers of electricity of alternative source energy (the "ASE"). From the working paper submitted by ME SR follows below tender conditions and prerequisites for the new sources of the green energy:

Available capacity (subject matter of the tender)

- 30 MW of the electricity produced from the ASE

New potential sources (parameters)

- **Solar energy**
 - Installed power from 100 kW to 1 MW
 - Location on the roof, external cladding of the buildings or on the land which is not an agricultural land
- **Other energy sources**
 - Installed power from 500 kW to 10MW

Conditions for the participation in the tender

- Submission of the separate application and the separate price offer on the blank forms prepared by ME SR
- The bidder can submit 5 price offers at the most
- Only criterion of assessing the quotations is the amount of the offered price EUR/MWh (the lowest price wins)
- Price neutrality (price is the same for all energy sources)

Demonstration of the conditions:

- The bidder may not have arrears in taxes, customs, levies, penalties, may not be in the insolvency, restructuring or liquidation proceedings
- Affidavit that the bidder is not a firm in difficulty
- Affidavit on submission of the Contract on the supplementary charge with OKTE, a.s.

Time period for submitting bids:

- Three months after the publication of the tender notice, however the bid must be submitted at the latest 30 days before lapse of this period

Bid evaluation process

1. ME SR evaluates whether the application or the price offer comply with minimum formal requirements, if not, the bid is not taken into further consideration
2. OKTE, a.s evaluates whether the Contract on the supplementary charge is duly completed, if not, the bid is not taken into further consideration
3. Deposition of the guarantee in amount of EUR 200,000 EUR/MW in the form of (a) finance deposit, (b) the bank guarantee, (c) combination of the finance deposit and the bank guarantee
4. OKTE, a.s. informs ME SR about the fulfilment of the obligations resulting from the Contract on the supplementary charge and on the deposition of the guarantee, if not, the bid is not taken into further consideration
5. MH SR opens and evaluates the price offers

Conditions for placing the new source in operation

- Photovoltaic sources - 18 months from the end the tender
- Other sources – 36 months from the end of the tender

Time period for granting the supplementary charge

- 15 years from placing the new source in the operation
