

# Legal Alert

Vision tests for staff operating motor vehicles

October 2011

**An amendment to the Regulation of the Minister of Health dated 7 January 2004 on Medical Exams for Drivers and Persons Seeking Authorization to Operate Motor Vehicles went into effect on 29 June 2011.**

Among the changes introduced, consultation with an optometrist and testing of mesopic vision and glare sensitivity are now mandatory for persons holding driver's licences in categories A, A1, B, B1, B+E and T who operate motor vehicles as part of their employment duties.

This requirement also applies to persons serving as commercial or medical representatives.
